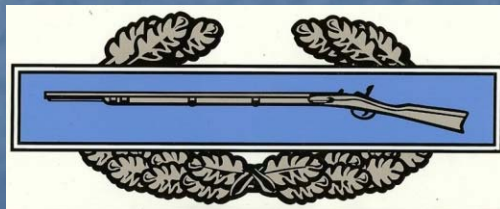

Saw injured women/children and were unable to help.

It's common for veterans to experience concerns related to readjustment issues after returning home and while reintegrating into civilian life.

That's why the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) provides support for combat veterans and their families at community-based counseling facilities called **Vet Centers**.
