Vet Center Eligibility

Any Veteran or Active-Duty Service Member, to include federally activated members of the National Guard and Reserves Components, are eligible.

If you have

Have served on active military duty in any combat theater / Campaign or area of hostility.

Experienced a military sexual trauma/Harassment.

Provided direct <u>emergent medical care or mortuary services</u>, while serving on active military duty, to the casualties of war.

Served stateside during a <u>national disaster</u> as a member of the National Guard or Reserve.

Served as a member of an <u>unmanned aerial vehicle crew</u> that provided direct support to operations in a combat zone or area of hostility.

Participated in a drug interdiction operation as a member of the U.S. Coast Guard (regardless of location.)

Reserve Components Behavioral Health Conditions or Psychological Trauma

Vietnam Era veterans who have accessed care at a Vet Center prior to January 1, 2004





Eligibility

All services are <u>prepaid</u> through military service and available throughout the <u>lifetime</u> of the veteran and or Service Member

Veterans and or Service Member are not required to have enrolled with a VA Medical Center for medical treatment in order to access Vet Center services.
